Evangelism


Our ministry to those who are foreigners and aliens to God's grace in Christ

Our ministry to one another to love and serve each other


Learning

Our Leadership Structures

Jesus Christ is the head and ruler of his church - the foundation and chief cornerstone on which we are being built (Ephesians 2:20). Our church in Rockhampton is a **Presbyterian Church** which means we are ruled by elders. All of our ministries are structured into these four aspects of the christian life and so our leadership structures are also divided into these four ministries all under the oversight and spiritual direction given by elders. Each ministry is under the direction of the elders and has a ministry leader who works with a team and trains and identifies new leaders. It is expected that all members of our church participate in a balance of these four key areas of **worship, learning, evangelism** and **loving** and that all members have an active serving ministry role in at least one of them.
